"From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand" -Matthew 4:7



Do you know how to get to heaven? Would you like to know for sure the way to go to heaven?

If you were to die today, are you sure you would go to heaven?

The information on how to get to heaven after death is listed below. Most people will ask "what must I do to go to heaven?" or "do good people automatically go to heaven after they die?"

These are questions and thoughts everyone has had at various times in their lives. Most people think if they are a good person they will automatically be allowed to enter heaven after they die.

Unfortunately, according to the Bible, that is not the case:

"Enter in through the narrow gate, for wide the gate and broad the way that leads to destruction, and many are they who enter in through it. For narrow the gate and straitened the way that leads to life, and they are few who find it. Not every one who says to me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of the heavens, but he that does the will of my Father who is in the heavens"- Matthew 7:13-14,21

You see, we were originally created by God to be sinless enlightened creatures in his own image.

"This is the book of Adam's generations. In the day that God created man, in the likeness of God made he him. Male and female created he them; and blessed them." - Genesis 5:1-2

God made the Earth and the Garden of Eden for us to live in perfect harmony with Him and his other creations of various animal and plant life forms. Sin and evil were not supposed to be in this equation. God created us to fellowship with him as his children. Adam and Eve lived

- Isaiah 59:2

22 And the LORD God said, Behold, the man is become as one of us, to know good and evil; and now, lest he put forth his hand, and take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live for ever: 24 So he drove out the man; and he placed at the east of the garden of Eden the Cherubim, and the flame of a sword which turned every way, to keep the way of the tree of life.

- Genesis 3:22,24

God, our Heavenly Father, in His infinite love and mercy, took Adam and Eve out of Eden so they would not eat of the tree of eternal life, which grew in the garden, so we would not be trapped for all eternity in our sinful state, and therefore, doomed to be separated from Him forever.

"And God saw that the wickedness of Man was great on the earth, and every imagination of the thoughts of his heart only evil continually. And God repented that he had made Man on the earth, and it grieved him in his heart. And God said, I will destroy Man, whom I have created, from the earth -- from man to cattle, to creeping things, and to fowl of the heavens; for I repent that I have made them."

- Genesis 6:5-7

"But Noah found favour in the eyes of God. This is the history of Noah. Noah was a just man, perfect amongst his generations: Noah walked with God. And Noah begot three sons, Shem, Ham, and Japheth. And the earth was corrupt before God, and the earth was full of violence. And God looked upon the earth, and behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted its way on the earth. And God said to Noah, The end of all flesh is come before me, for the earth is full of violence through them; and behold, I will destroy them with the earth. Make thyself an ark of gopher wood: [with] cells shalt thou make the ark; and pitch it inside and outside with pitch. And thus shalt thou make it: let the length of the ark be

three hundred cubits, the breadth of it fifty cubits, and the height of it thirty cubits. A light shalt thou make to the ark; and to a cubit high shalt thou finish it above. And the door of the ark shalt thou set in its side: [with] a lower, second, and third [story] shalt thou make it. For I, behold, I bring a flood of waters on the earth, to destroy all flesh under the heavens in which is the breath of life: everything that is on the earth shall expire.

But with thee will I establish my covenant; and thou shalt go into the ark, thou, and thy sons, and thy wife, and thy sons' wives with thee. And of every living thing of all flesh, two of every [sort] shalt thou bring into the ark, to keep [them] alive with thee: they shall be male and female. Of fowl after their kind, and of the cattle after their kind, of every creeping thing of the ground after its kind, two of each shall go in to thee, to keep [them] alive. And take thou of all food that is eaten, and gather [it] to thee, that it may be for food for thee and for them. And Noah did it; according to all that God had commanded him, so did he. - Genesis 6:8-22

Noah and his family were spared, as well as the earth, and the chosen creations God had told Noah to save on the ark. But sin was still with them and in the world, as illustrated further on in the book of Genesis.

"And the people of Sodom were wicked, and great sinners before God" - Genesis 13:13

The Lord God, in his never-ending mercy and love for us, provided a way to correct our sinful corrupted condition by sending his son Jesus Christ, in human form, down to Earth to live among us without the taint and corruption of sin. Jesus taught us a way out of this curse of evil.

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only-begotten Son, that whosoever believes on him may not perish, but have life eternal."

- John 3:16

Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life: he that believes on me, though he have died, shall live; and every one who lives and believes on me shall never die." - John 11:25-26

To be saved from our corrupted sinful existence, we must acknowledge and understand that we are evil and have sinned. We must believe that Jesus Christ sacrificed himself for us because of our sins.

"The Father loves the Son, and has placed all things in his hands. He that believes on the Son has life eternal, and he that believes not in the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides upon him." - John 3:35-36

And it came to pass as they were in perplexity about it, that behold, two men suddenly stood by them in shining raiment. And as they were filled with fear and bowed their faces to the ground, they said to them, Why seek ye the living one among the dead? He is not here, but is risen: remember how he spoke to you, being yet in Galilee, saying, The Son of man must be delivered up into the hands of sinners, and be crucified, and rise the third day." - Luke 24:1-7

"And as they were saying these things, Jesus himself stood in their midst, and says to them, Peace [be] unto you. But they, being confounded and being frightened, supposed they beheld a spirit. And he said to them, Why are ye troubled? and why are thoughts rising in your hearts? Behold my hands and my feet, that it is I myself. Handle me and see, for a

spirit has not flesh and bones as ye see me having. And having said this he shewed them his hands and his feet. And he led them out as far as Bethany, and having lifted up his hands, he blessed them. And it came to pass as he was blessing them, he was separated from them and was carried up into heaven." - Luke 24:36-40,50-51

God has never turned his back on us or stopped loving us because we are his children and his creation. God yearns to have a relationship with us. To really know God, we have to ask for redemption through Jesus Christ.
